- Vestry is in agreement with Ken's recommendation to replace the light over the church door with LED

10. OTHER BUSINESS

- 10.1 <u>West Winnipeg viability committee news</u> There is a fundraiser at St. Mary's on November 5th. It will be an "Elvis/Johnny Cash" evening and tickets are \$25. Proceeds are going to outreach, not to individual churches. Pat Gerow reported that for the long term, we are to come up with our own vision.
- 10.2 <u>Coffee Hour Hosts</u> Coffee hour will now be on alternate Sundays beginning on the Oct. 22nd.
- 10.<u>3 PWRDF</u> a representative volunteer from St. Andrew's is requested.
- 10.4 <u>Family Dynamics</u> a rep is requested to be a liaison between them and St. Andrews.
- 10.5 <u>Vendor Sale</u> It will be held on December 3rd from 10 to 3. There are 22 vendors and only need one more for a full complement.
- 10.6 <u>Sexual Harassment Prevention Training-</u> This training will occur on November 5th beginning with a lunch at noon and workshops to follow. This session will be facilitated by the Rev. Canon Mary Holmen with the Rev Deacon Susan Smandych assisting with instruction. Wardens and Vestry are asked to attend but it is open to all.
- 10.7 <u>Report on missing plates for the Prayer Garden</u>– The missing bronze markers for the memory cross have been done, along with a plate paying tribute to Wes Tully who made

the cross for us. These will be put up shortly. Ken would like to see the Wes Tully cross put on the north wall between the windows.

- 10.9 <u>Connecting</u> Articles to be submitted by October 19th. The Connecting will go out after the Parish meeting.
